Your attention is again called to the provisions of Rule 502 of the Commission Rules and Regulations. It is apparent from the interpretation as to the overage and underage in your letter of December 19, 1936 that a misunderstanding exists. Basically the rule reads that any over-production in any one month must be made up the following month. Any under-production that is incurred during a month ~~cannot~~ be made up in any succeeding month. Further, special instructions are given to explain over-production which has not been done.

Upon careful examination of the Rules and Regulations, particularly Section G, one will note that your company is in apparent violation in several instances. Further, you are requested to read Section 63-3-27 "Penalties for Violations-Accessories" which appears on page 79 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules and Regulations.

Due to the discrepancies that exist between statements from your purchaser and the certified form C-115 you are hereby directed to submit purchaser's statements since the date this well was completed, and file corrected form C-115 for each month that does not agree.

Further, upon receipt of the above requested statements you will receive by return mail the correct figure of over-production that must be made up at the earliest possible date.

The allowable for the month of December is 1080 barrels.
