Ran 168' of 13-3/8" 48# seamless H-40 casing and set at 174'. Cemented with 100 sacks of Neat and circulated to the bottom of the cellar. Tested pipe and casing seat with 700 psi for 30 minutes before and after the drilling out of the cement on August 22, 1955, and both held OK.
