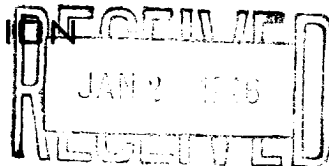

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The cement plug was drilled by cable tools from the 5-1/2" pipe and the hole was drilled to 2,990 feet. The 5-1/2" casing had been cemented on December 17th at 2,978 feet with 600 sacks. After drilling plug, the well was tested by running the bailer and the cement job was found to be satisfactory.
