It was temporarily abandoned per notice dated 11/17/53, approved 11/23/53 and per report 12/29/53 approved 1/6/54. We propose to truck any oil produced to tank battery at Well No. 2 on same lease. Should these tests indicate present commercial production from this well proper notice will be filed of our intention to place same on the pump.

Gentlemen:

Some years ago we drilled New Mexico State Lease Well No.1 located in the NE/4 of the NE/4 of Section 36, T-12-S, R-31-E, N.M.P.M. Chaves County, New Mexico. This well is in the Caprock Queen Field. At the time the well was drilled it was a portion of New Mexico State Lease No. B-9986-9 comprising 717.08 acres. This lease was forfeited or released by our Company and repurchased again at an oral bid sale in Santa Fe, and now bears the New Mexico State Lease No. E-7516 and comprises 717.08 acres.

At the time Well No.1 was drilled we encountered the Queen sand at about the usual depth, and apparently it had some oil in it and just a little gas. The sand looked reasonably good, but simply would not give up any oil, water or gas. In accordance with the rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission we temporarily abandoned this well on December 10th, 1953, leaving all casing in the hole. The well has been shut in until a few days ago.

Some days ago we opened up the well and found that it was making a very very small amount of gas and when a small pebble was dropped in the well we could tell it hit fluid. We then moved in a small cable tool drilling machine and bailed the well. We found that it had 540' of oil and no water in it. We attempted to bail the well dry and bailed 28 barrels of oil from the well. It was still making just a little oil when we quit bailing the second day. We simply wanted to find out about this well and since it was ours we went over and tested it strictly on our own.

We have a second well on this same lease known as New Mexico State Well No. 2 located in the SW/4 of the NE/4 of Section 2, T-14-S, R-31-E, Chaves County, New Mexico. This well, of course, is in the Caprock Queen Field at present and the Unit No. is "G".

We were a little surprised that Well No.1 made any oil at all, but as stated above it did bail 28 barrels of oil and not knowing what else to do with it we have trucked the oil to the tank battery near Well No. 2.

When the oil is run the State of New Mexico will, of course, receive their royalty.

Possibly we are a little bit late, but we would like to know if this procedure is alright with the New Mexico State Land Office as to the 28 barrels of oil previously produced, and we wish to make further tests on the well as soon as same is approved by the New Mexico State Conservation Commission and would like to also truck this oil and place it in the tank battery at No. 2 well.

You understand, of course, that both of these wells are on the same New Mexico State Lease, namely, No. E-7516 consisting of 717.08 acres.

We are sort of "babes in the woods" when it comes to matters of this kind and will greatly appreciate hearing from you on this situation.

Should the tests we propose to make be favorable, we would then like to obtain permission to place a tank at No.1 well and truck the oil down to the tank battery at Well No. 2. While you are at it, will you also advise us if we can do this in accordance with your rules and regulations.

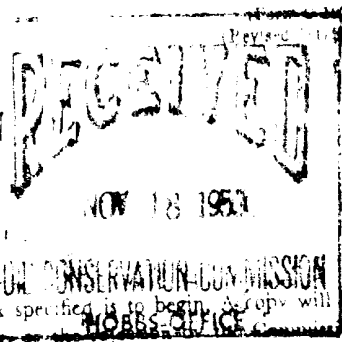

Base of salt 2,250'. Top Yates 2,450'. Pay section drilled with cable tools and was hard and tight. Hole has no water, oil or gas. Will clean up around location and cover well. Plan to later test San Andres and Grayberg.
