In reply to your letter, a copy of which was mailed to me, addressed to Mr. J. O. Denton, Jr., regarding the Notice of Intention to Deepen the State-Maxwell "B" #1 Well, in the SWSE Sec. 12, T. 13S, R. 31E. My records reflect a Form C-110 dated August 29, 1947, and approved by Roy Yarbrough August 31, 1947, changing the Operator from Great Western Producers, Inc., to Cooperative Producing Association. We did not list this as a deepening but rather as a clean out operation. I believe you will agree with us after checking these two forms.

Upon checking the George L. Harris file I find the well to be in Sec. 2, T. 13 N, R. 33E, and to have been drilled in August, September, and November of 1946. On October 11, 1947, I received a Form C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill, approved by Betty Wistrand on October 9, 1947. I believe if you will check correspondence concerning this well, you will find that there was trouble concerning the bond and that the well was shut down for this reason long before the Form C-101 was approved. If there have been any other operations on this well, we have had no report either from the Oil Scouts or George L. Harris.

I hope this information will be of assistance to you. If you would like a copy of the Form C-110 on the Cooperative Producing Assn. please advise me.
