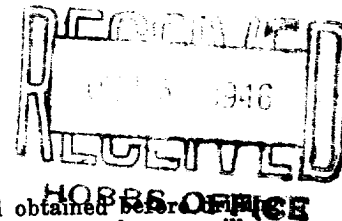

On March 27, 1968, at about 10:00 AM, I was working my station HRP over shore the town of Long Beach, CA. During the  
morning hours, I observed several small boats moving along the coast. At approximately 11:00 AM, I observed a large  
ship, which appeared to be a tugboat, moving along the coast. The ship was white with a red stripe along its side.  
I observed the ship from a distance of approximately 1 mile. The ship was moving towards the south.
