DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Found top savings at 3032'. Cleaned out from 3032' to 3060' with sand pump.
Ran 4½" OD 11½ insert liner, stopped at casing shoe. Drove 65.36' of 4½"
liner from 3003' to 3060', top liner at 2995'. Perforations 3043' - 3060'.
cave catcher set at 3043'. Ran tubing, pump and rods.

RESULTS: Pumped 74 bbls oil no water thru 2-3/8" tubing in 48 hours, 20 x 36"
SPM. Daily average production for December 1952 19 bbls oil no water per day.
Daily allowable for January 1953 20 bbls oil per day. Allowable after clean
out job 30 bbls oil per day.
