This well was spudded on July 11, 1947. On July 12, 1947 we ran 276 feet ~~xx~~ of ~~2~~ 32 Pound, 9 5/8" Casing and circulated to surface with 175 Sax of cement. After allowing the cement to set for 48 Hours we tested for a successful water-shut-off. No water was found to be present in the bore hole. Drilling was resumed.
