DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was first cleaned out to the top of the pay section at 3057 feet. 46 sacks of calseal were used to fill up the hole to the bottom of the casing at 3032 ft. The calseal was drilled and the hole cleaned out through the pay section to the well's total depth of 3068 ft.

Halliburton's sand-oil process was given, using 10,500 gal. of gas-oil and 12,500 lbs. of sand through 2 1/2" tubing.

The well has been pumping 70 bbls. per day since treatment (this includes sand-frac fluid).
