Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

This well was drilled to 295' in Red Bed. Ran 7 joints, 280.36' of 8 5/8" OD 22.7# Armo SW SJ casing set at 292' and cemented with 175 sacks of neat cement. Cement circulated. Plug was down at 8:10 A. M. August 21, 1955. After allowing cement to set for 24 hours, 500# pressure was applied with all valves closed during a 30 minute interval with no drop in pressure. Test was made prior to and after drilling plug.
