Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

This well was drilled to 3081' in anhydrite. Ran 96 joints, 3072.67' of 5½" OD 11½" ER J-55 SS casing set at 3079' and cemented with 300 sacks neat cement. Plug was down at 6:10 a.m., 9-15-55. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours before testing for shut-off. Prior to and after drilling plug, 1000# pressure was applied with no drop in pressure during a 30 minute interval. Shoe was not drilled out.
