## INSTRUCTIONS

This certificate is to be completed and filed in QUADRIPLER A-15 with the District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, covering each unit from which oil or gas is produced. A separate certificate shall be filed for each transporter authorized to transport oil or gas from a unit. After said certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, one copy shall be forwarded to the transporter, one copy to the oil or gas producer, and two copies retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A separate report shall be filed to cover each change in operating ownership and control of the transporter, except that in the case of a temporary change in the transporter in excess of less than the allowable production for one operation period, the transporter shall be notified by a new certificate notify the Oil Conservation Commission of the change. The transporter authorized by certificate on file with the Commission shall be notified of the estimated amount of oil or gas to be moved by the transporter and the name of such temporary transporter. If such notice shall also be furnished such temporary transporter, the temporary transporter shall not move any more oil or gas than the estimated amount shown in said notice.

This certificate when properly executed and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission shall constitute a permit for pipe line connection and authorization to transport oil and gas from the property named therein and shall remain in full force and effect until:

- (a) The rating ownership changes
- (b) The transporter is changed or
- (c) The permit is cancelled by the Commission.

If a copy of the rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission have been incorporated into the same time this report is filed, explain fully under "Other Information" the following:
