 Ran 85.9 jts 2832' 5 1/2" OD 14 3/8" J-55 SS Casing set at 2840 and  
 cemented with 300 sacks of cement. Plug was down at 4:00 P.M.  
 2-24-55. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours before testing for  
 shut-off. Shut-off test was satisfactory. Drilling resumed.
