Ran 3034' of 5-1/2" 14# Seamless J-55 casing and set at 3036'. Cemented with 100 sacks of Neat. Temperature survey found the top of the cement at 2655'. Tested pipe and casing seat with 1000 psi for 30 minutes before and after the drilling out of the cement on March 1, 1955, and both held OK.
