Subject well was plugged 6/4/70 by Cities Service Oil Company by setting cast iron bridge plug at 3053 - capped with 25 sacks cement 3053 - 2833 and a 10 sack surface plug.

It is proposed to re-enter, shoot off 5 1/2" casing at 2000, spot 100' plug across casing stub, 100' plug across top of salt at 1500, 100' plug across 8 5/8" casing @ 355, 10 sack plug at surface. In this manner 2000' of 5 1/2" casing will be recovered and the well more properly plugged to protect surface water.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
