Re: Form C-102 State #3

We do not quite understand your reason for filing Form C-102 stating that the lead oil has not been recovered and that the well is making 100 % salt water in view of the fact that you filed Form C-104 on August 23rd, reporting a test of 91.6 bbl. of oil in 24 hours. It was on the basis of this test that we assigned the well an allowable of 39 bbls. daily effective August 18th, and as of this date we have received no request for the cancellation of the allowable. Please explain in detail why the production test was reported on Form C-104 when the lead oil had not been recovered.

In view of the above information the allowable for this well will be discontinued as of October 31st.
