### DETAILS OF WORK

Total depth 373' in Red Bed. Run 9 jts 360' of 3 5/8" OD Lucas 24 casing set at 373' and cemented with 200 sacks. Cement circulated. Rig was down at 5:00 A.M., September 6, 1954. Cement was allowed to set 36 hours before testing for shut-off. Test was satisfactory. Drilling resumed.
