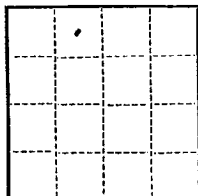

DETAILS OF WORK

This well was drilled to 293' in red bed. Has 200' of 8 5/8" OD 22.7# iron SW 3J casing set at 293' and cemented with 150 sacks. Cement circulated. Plug was down at 10:00 P.M. October 19, 1954. Shut-off test was made after allowing 24 hours for cement to set. Test was satisfactory and drilling was resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
