DETAILS OF WORK

This well was drilled to 2875' in anhydrite. Ran 88 joints (2868') of 5 1/2" OD 14 1/2 SE J-55 SC casing set at 2874' and cemented with 300 sacks of neat cement. Plug was down at 8:30 A.M. December 7, 1954. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours before testing for shut-off. Test was satisfactory. Drilling resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
