DETAILS OF WORK

I plan to drill a 2300' Queen sand test, using rotary to approximately 2765' and cable tools from there to total depth.

8-5/8" surface casing will be run to 100' and cemented with 50 sacks. This should circulate to surface.

The 5" oil string will be set in the anhydrite caprock above the Queen sand at approximately 2765' with 100 sacks.

All casing will be run and cemented under methods approved by the U. S. Geological Survey.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

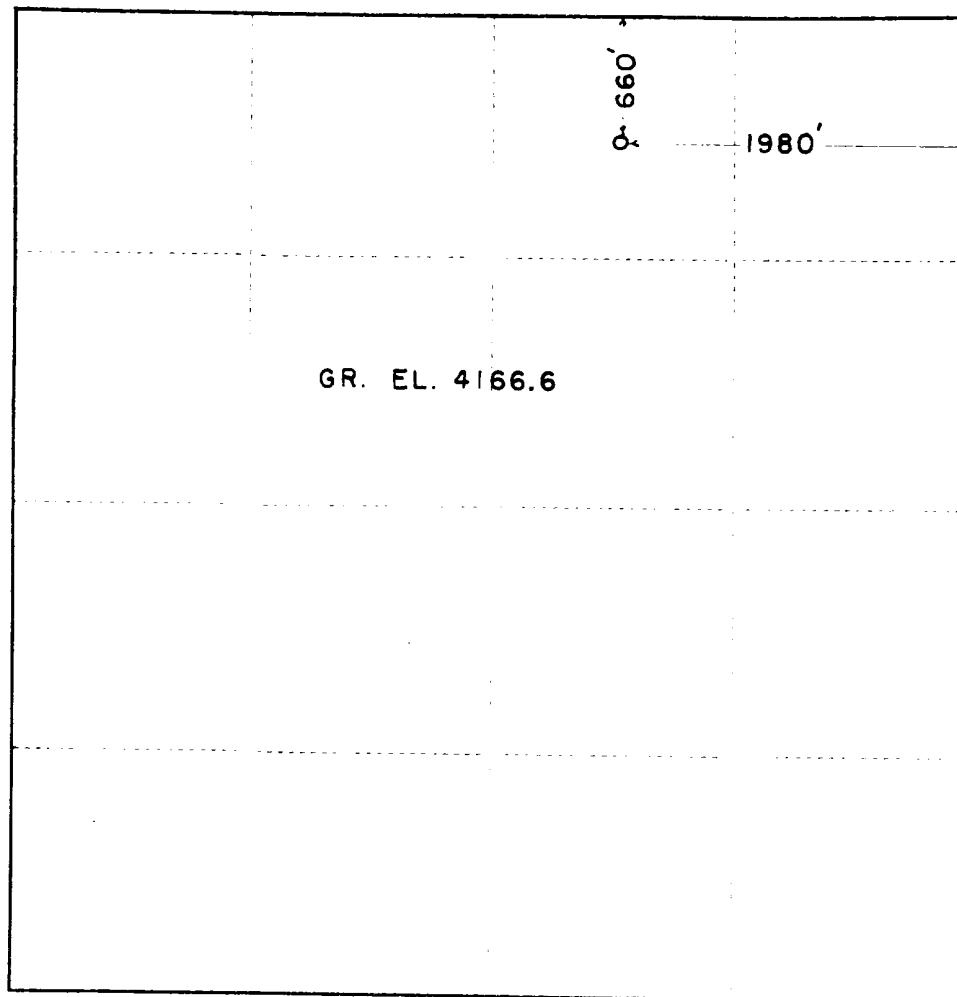
