WE PROPOSE TO DISC OR RIP SOIL AND BROADCAST AMMONIUM SULFATE. AMOUNT TO BE APPROXIMATELY 400# PER ACRE OVER DAMAGED SOIL. THE DAMAGED SOIL ON THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITE WILL NOT BE RIPPED, BUT WILL HAVE AMMONIUM SULFATE BROADCASTED OVER THE SITE AND SPRAYED WITH FRESH WATER. THIS SHOULD RESTORE THE SOIL BACK TO ITS NATURAL VEGETATIVE STATE. WORK WILL COMMENCE WITHIN 5 DAYS OF BLM APPROVAL.
