1. Set a CI Bridge Plug @ 3000. (7" set @ 3068 w/125 sxs.
2. Set a 25 sack cement plug on top of bridge plug @ 3000-2850.
3. Loaded hole with mud laden fluid.
4. Set a 10 sack cement surface plug @ 30-0 with a 4" marker extending 4' above the surface to designate a P & A location.
5. Location has been cleared of all debris and equipment and is ready for final inspection.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or may be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
