Ran 8 jts, 248', 8-5/8" OD 21# J-55 SS casing. Set and cemented at 258' with 175 sacks regular cement. Plug at 238'. Maximum pressure 200#. Circulated approximately 25 sacks cement. Job complete 2:00 p.m. 5-11-59.

After waiting over 24 hours, tested 8-5/8" casing with 1000# for 30 minutes. No drop. Drilled plug and tested below casing shoe with 300# for 30 minutes. No drop.

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
