The subject well was plugged and abandoned as a dry hole. 832' of 4 1/2" casing was removed. Cement plugs set as follows: 12 sack plug 3012-3133', 20 sack plug 800-900', 30 sack plug 263-363', 15 sack plug surface to 50'. A 4" x 4' marker was erected at surface and location restored to its original condition. Plugging started 4-20-57. Plugging completed 4-21-57.
