On May 18, 1956, 9 jts. (299.92') of 13-3/8"-40#-H-40 seamless casing was set at 307' with 300 sxs of regular neat cement. Plug was pumped down at 6:15 A.M., May 18, 1956.

After 12 hours, the well was nipple up. After 24 hours the casing was tested with 1000# pressure for 30 min. before and after drilling plug. Test was successful.
