This well was P & A in April 1965. We propose to move in rotary tools, drill out cement plugs to 4450', condition hole and run formation analysis logs of San Andres. If logs warrant, we propose to set 4-1/2" casing to 4450' and cement w/225 sx; perforate San Andres, acidize w/2000 gallons 15% LSTNE and frac w/20,000 gallons of lease crude containing 20,000# of 20/40 sand. This work will be started approximately May 10, 1966.

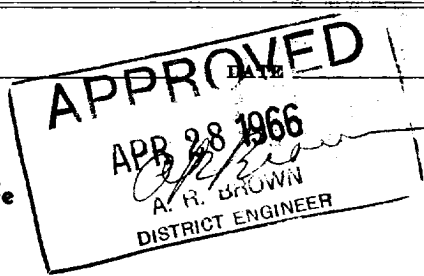

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
