The Wolf Federal #1 was drilled 50 4,248' as of December 19, 1964. 4,230' of 4½" casing was cemented at 4,244' with 100 sacks plus 35 sacks of stratacrete, December 23, 1964. On December 28, the well was logged and perforated 4,084 - 88, 4,132 - 4,139', and 4,142 - 4,146 with 2 shots per foot. The perforations were acidized with 3,000 gallons of acid and 500 gallons gelled acid on January 4, 1965. Mud water (4 B.P.H. and trace of oil). On January 3, 1965 acidized with 2,000 gallons and tested zone (4,084 - 88). Made 6 barrels per hour (salt water). Squeezed all zones with 100 sacks. Drilled out and reperforated 4,142 - 46 and 4,132 - 39. Acidized 2,000 gallons, made 3 barrels per hour. Perforated 4,084 - 88, 2 shots per foot, acidized 2,000 gallons - made salt water only.

We plan to set cement plugs as follows:

25 sacks at 4,000'

About 2,000' of 4½" will be pulled.

25 sacks at Stub of 4½" at about 2,000'

25 sacks at base of 8 5/8 at 370'

10 sacks at surface.

The location will be cleaned and a proper marker placed.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
