
Dear Sir:

As requested by your letter of June 1, 1966, we are enclosing Form C-103 outlining the work done prior to plugging and the Deviation Report on the Bell State No. 1, located in Unit P, Sec. 15, T-18S, R-32E, Chaves County, New Mexico. Also enclosed are copies of forms (C105) which were submitted January 21, 1965.

The well was originally drilled to a total depth of 4855' between January 2, 1965 and January 14, 1965, and plugged as a dry hole. Then we re-entered same on March 15, 1965 and drilled to a total depth of 9095' which we plugged April 15, 1965.
