On 3/29/67 perforated 4-1/2" casing w/1 shot to interval @ 3287, 3283, 3278, 3277, 3276, 3273, 3270, and 3261. Followed w/treatment of 1000 gal MDC acid and loaded hole. Started swabbing and swabbed back load and sulphur water with no oil or gas show. No other senses on log indicated potential production. As well is a dry hole we propose to plug and abandon the location in the following manner:

Set 20 ex cement plug from 4378 (plug back depth) to 3200'; set 25 ex cement plug in and out of shoot-off point; set 25 ex cement plug 1390-1300; set 25 ex cement plug 370-285 (in and out of casing shoe set at 332'); 10 ex cement plug 30'- surface of ground. All intervals between plugs to be filled with mud. Area will be cleared of equipment, surface returned to natural contour and marker set to identify the location.

Verbal authority granted to proceed with above work by Mr. J. H. Southerland, Engineer, U. S. Geological Survey.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
