No productive zones were encountered in this well. We propose to plug and abandon on September 11, 1967, as follows:

25 sacks cement at 3989-3840';
Shoot off 4-1/2" casing at 2810' (top of cement is 2840');
25 sacks cement at 2800-2710';
25 sacks cement at 1900-1810';
25 sacks cement at 1400-1310';
25 sacks cement at 262-162';
10 sacks cement at the surface with a steel marker.

Hole will be filled with 8.9# mud and well site will be cleared and conditioned for final inspection.

a cement plug is placed from 150 feet to
450 feet.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
