If not filed prior to the final primary record, a summary record, a copy of all currently available logs (drillers, geologists, sampler and core analysis), all types of logs, data, and information and pressure tests, and directional surveys, should be attached hereto, to the extent required by applicable Federal and/or State laws and regulations. All attachments should be listed on this form, see item 25.
