1. Pulled tbq, DC's & bit. Perforated Yates with 4-JSPF 1650-1660, 1670-1680, 1690-1700, 1710-1720, 1730-1740 (200 holes).
2. Ran 48 jts 2-3/8" J-55 tbq with Baker Model R double grip pkr with 1-4', 1-8' sub. Acidized with 6000 gals 15% HCL containing 5 gal/1000 gal 14-N + 1 gal/1000 gals inhibitor. Pumped 1000 gal acid dropped 10 RCNBS. Pumped 50-100 gals w/4 RCNBS between each stage.
3. Flushed acid to formation w/formation water. Had 400 psi on 4-1/2" x 9-5/8" annulus. Ran 2" tbq and stringer back to retainer.
4. Ran Baker tension type pkr plastic coated on 50 jts 2" J-55 tbq w/1-8' & 1-6' PC subs. Set packer at 1594' w/8000# tension. Filled annulus with fresh water treated w/Tretolite 141.
5. Well completed as a SWD well.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
