1-9-68 drilled retainer and hard cement 3410-3455'. ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ pulled 2 3/8" tubing, drill collar and bit. Trip w/packer Roto Vert scraper. Pulled tubing and scraper. Lane wells perforated 4 1/2" casing with 1 jet shot at each interval, 3402, 05, 10, 14, 16, 19, 25, 27, 31, 38 & 40 using 3 1/8" selectkone eased gun 11 gram NCH II charge PA. Checked total depth and logged perfs. in place, o.k. Ran packer on tubing w/seat at 3453'. Set Packer. Tested plug 1000' 45 minutes, o.k. Displaced brine water with fresh water in hole. Reset packer and tubing seat now 3360'. Swabbing. 1-13-68 Chemical Engineers acidized perfs. 3402-3440' with 6000 gals. 28% NE NCH and 15 ball sealers down tubing. Loaded hole with acid broke down formation. Flushed with 87 barrels treated fresh water. Good ball action. Did not ball out. Swabbing.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
