3. Ran 107 jts 2" tubing, hung at 3447. Ran pump on 136-3/4" rods.
4. Placed well on production.

Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
