On October 4, 1969, rigged up Lea County Casing Pullers, With tubing set at total depth of 3580 feet, circulated hole with 10# per gal. mud and spotted cement plug from 3580 to 3280 feet with 25 sacks cement. On Oct. 6, 1969, pulled tubing and shot 4-1/2" casing at 3,000 feet, but could not work loose. Shot 4-1/2" casing at 2810 feet and pulled. Top of 4-1/2" casing stub in hole is at 2809 feet from surface with casing shoe at 3561 feet.

Ran tubing and set additional plugs as follows:

2809' to 2729' w/25 sx cement - top of 4-1/2" casing
1600' to 1525' w/25 sx cement - base of salt
400' to 325' w/25 sx cement - in and out of 8-5/8" casing @ 373'.
30' to surface w/10 sx cement - top of 8-5/8" casing.

Set 4-1/2" O.D. x 4' marker in top of casing. Notice will be sent as soon as location is cleared of material and ready for final inspection.

Casing left in hole:

752'-4-1/2", 9.5# 8-55 casing from 2809' to 3561'.
373'-8-5/8", 24# 8-55 casing from surface to 373'.

Instructions
