Using a pulling unit, completion operations were begun March 4, 1969. Plugged back T.D. was checked at 3561' and the casing perforated w/one shot each at 3511, 3524, 3526, 3528, 3531, 3537, 3543, and 3545 feet. The zones were treated with 16,750 gallons acid in four stages. The well swabbed dry after each stage without recovering acid water.

On March 20, a tracer was run indicating no channel above or below perforated zones. Using a reverse circulation rig, the hole was deepened from 3564 to 3580 feet. Treating below a packer set at 3560 feet, the open hole was treated with 1000 gallons 28% acid and then swabbed dry without recovering load. The packer was pulled and the hole circulated with hot oil and then displaced with brine water through tubing. The packer was re-run and set at 3557'. The open hole was treated with 1000 gallons 28% acid. The well swabbed dry without recovering load water or acid water. There were no shows of oil, gas, or formation water.

The well is temporarily abandoned with valves closed-in on both casing tubing.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
