Well History and Recommendation

Plug and abandon W. R. Means No. 1

It is recommended that we plug and abandon the subject well since the Queen gas zone is depleted and there are no remedial or recompletion possibilities.

Present Status:

The subject well is shut in and is not capable of production. A shut-in bottom hole pressure of 240 psi was measured in April 1976.

Discussion:

The W. R. Means No. 1 is located in the gas cap portion of the Vest Ranch Queen Pool. There are six producing wells completed in the oil rim portion of this Queen reservoir with a cumulative production of 106,000 barrels oil at 11-1-76.
