Will drill to approximately 600' and cement casing with 50 sx class "C" + 2% chloride. Will then drill to Queen at approx. 2300'. If production is indicated, will run 5 1/2" casing and will use macaroni pipe to circulate cement around 8 5/8" surface casing. If well is dry, will pull come of surface casing and set cement plugs.

Cortez Drilling Corp. Box 848, Roswell, New Mexico is the contractor.

Instructions

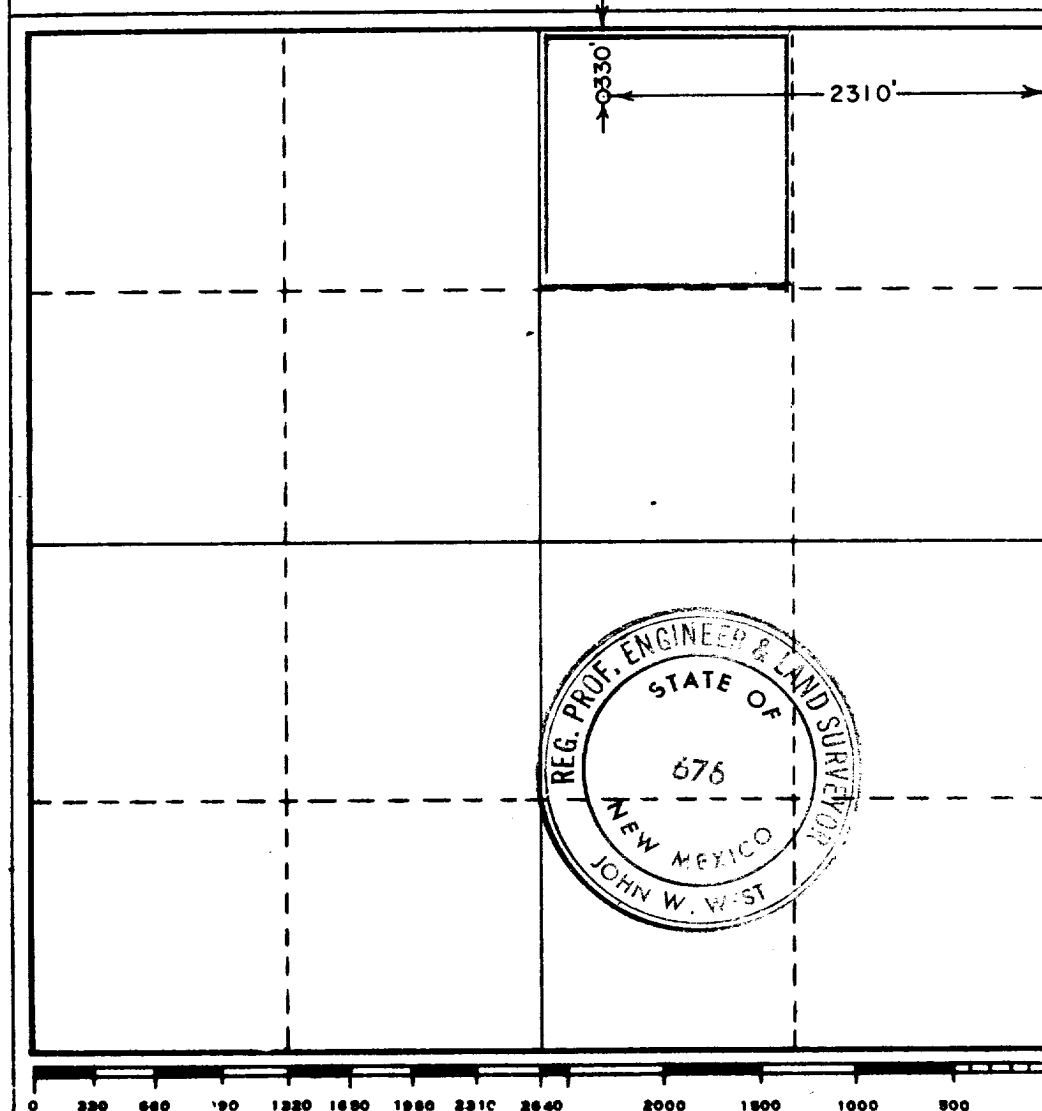
