Dear Sirs:

In accordance with your request, enclosed you will find Form 9-330, Well Completion or Recompletion Report, and a report of the production tests performed on subject well.

The delay in filing these reports was due to the fact that we considered the perforating and running of tubing in this well to be part of a testing program rather than a well completion. Due to the frequent occurrence of damage to the Morrow the testing program was designed so that the open perforations in the Morrow would not be subjected to contact with drilling fluids should the zone be commercial.

As the test indicated, the zone from 10,668' to 10,680' is non-commercial and will be squeezed off to permit additional testing.
