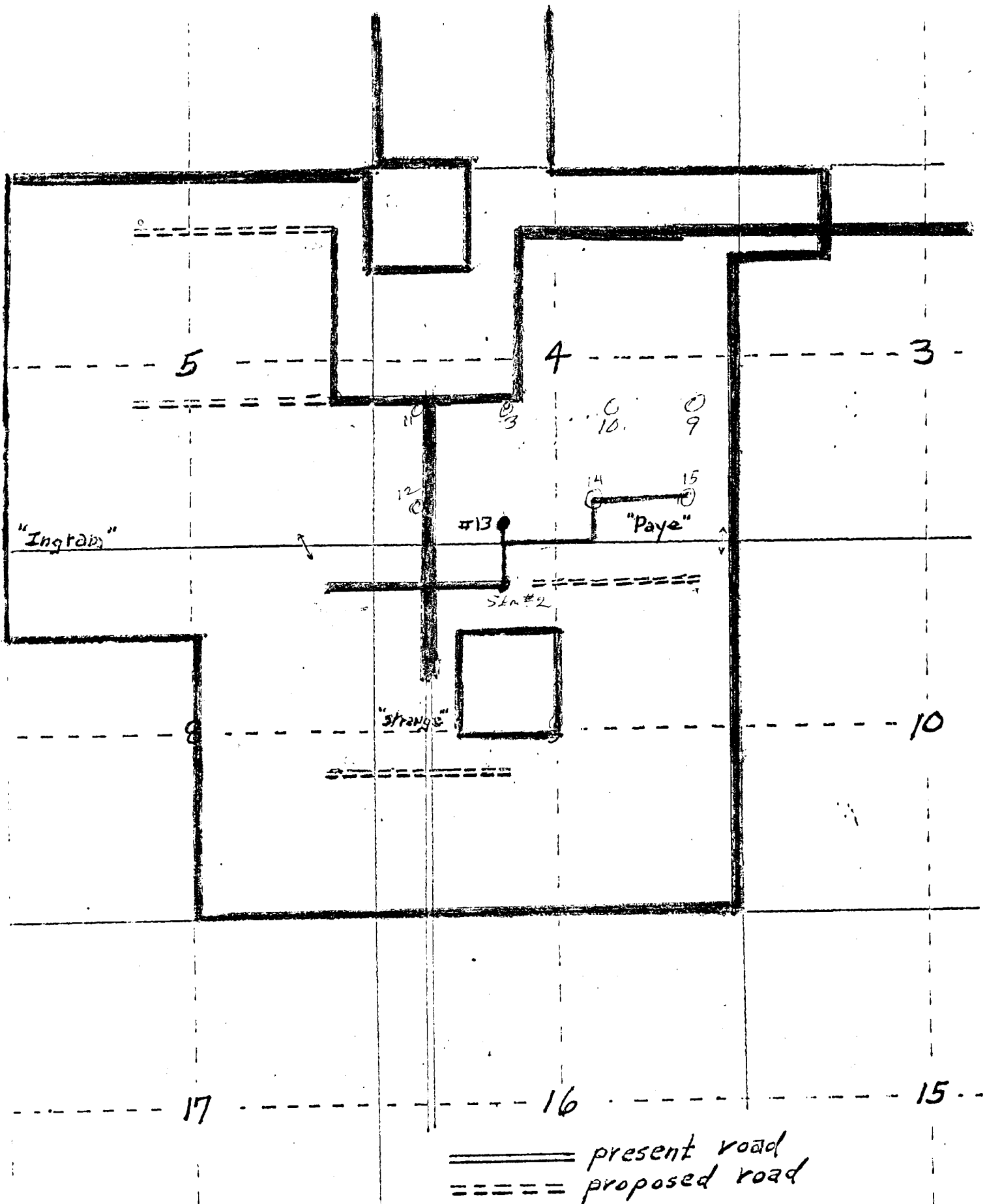

Series 900 Flanges per Beller



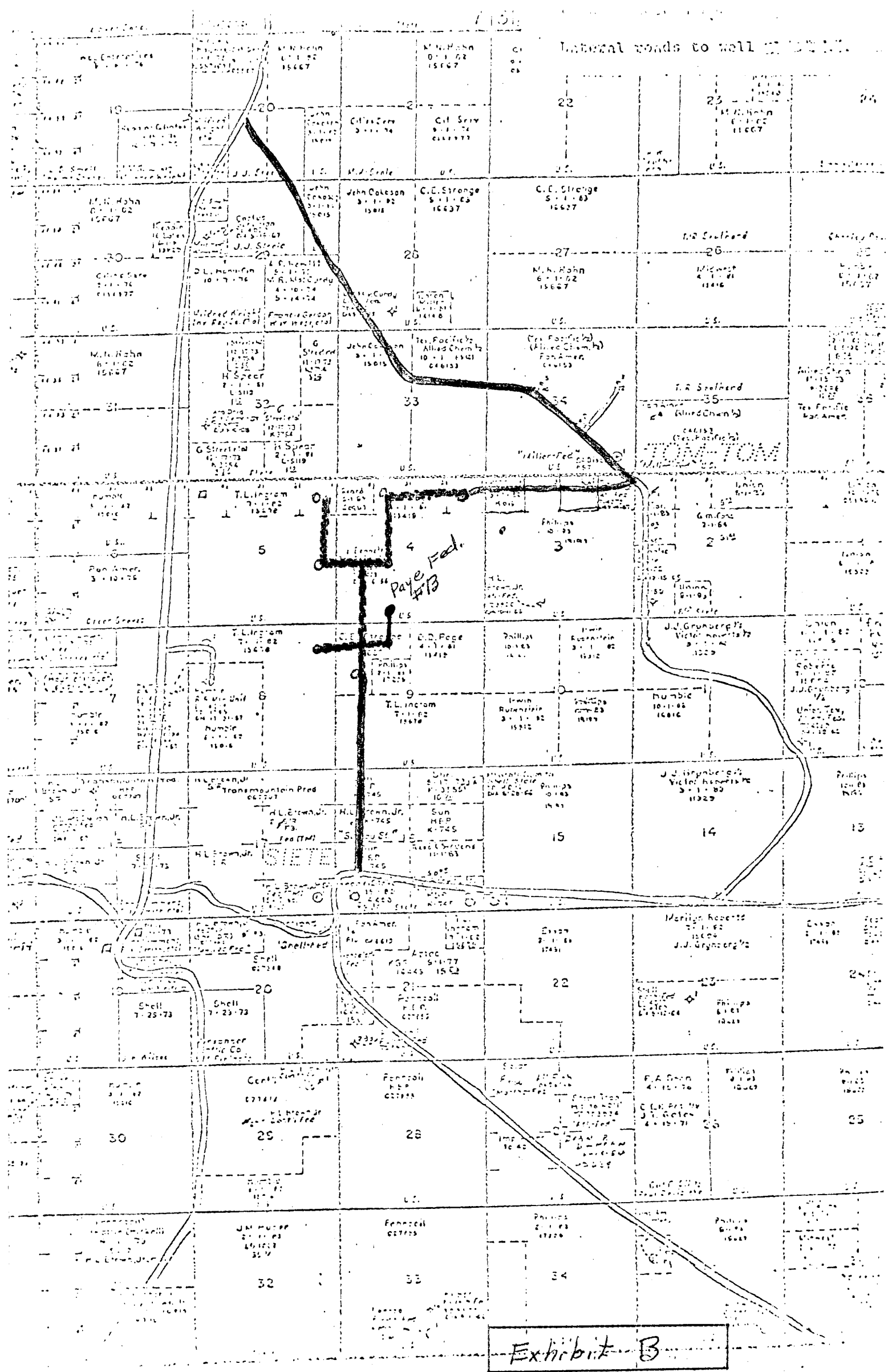
