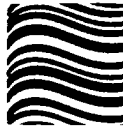

PLUGGING PROPOSAL

OPERATOR: WESTERN RESERVES OIL CO. INC. WELL: WESTERN RESERVES "34" FEDERAL #2
FIELD: TOM-TOM (SAN ANDRES) LOCATION: SECTION 34, T7S-R31E
COUNTY: CHAVES STATE: NEW MEXICO
TOTAL DEPTH: 4150' DATE: FEBRUARY 21, 1989 REV: 0

1. Rig up well plugging unit, pull and lay down rods and pump.
2. Pull 2 3/8" tubing and stand in derrick.
3. Rig up wireline and run in hole with gauge ring to 3960'±.
4. Set CIBP on wireline @ 3900'±, cap w/ ~~2~~ ^{35'} cement, *w/ dump trailer*, { 50' ~~up~~ *through tubing* -
5. Rig up and take stretch on 4 1/2" 9.5# K-55 ST&C csg. Should be free about 2800'.
6. Shot off csg and pull same. Run back to 3900' with tubing, displace hole with Salt Gel Mud.
7. Set a 35 sx plug across 4 1/2" csg stub @ 2800'. Tag this plug.
8. Set ~~35~~ ⁴³ sx plug @ 1600-1700' across 8 5/8" csg shoe @ 1657'. *Tag this plug.*
9. Set ~~40~~ ¹⁸ sx plug @ surface. Remove wellhead. Weld cap on 8 5/8" csg, install dry hole marker. Rig down plugging unit, cut off anchors, clean location and release unit.
10. Remove all equipment and clean location, prepare for inspection.
