John S. Goodrich respectfully requests approval for off-lease measurement of gas production from his Lois Federal well No.1, a new gas well in the SE¹/₄NW¹/₄ of Section 4, T.13 S., R.31 E., Chaves County, New Mexico, lease NM-015807.

This gas well is shut in at present because of no pipeline connection. Mr. Goodrich has filed an application with BLM for a R-O-W for a gas sales pipeline to connect this well to Cabot's existing gas gathering system in the area. When this R-O-W is approved, a 2-3/8" steel pipeline will be constructed from the Lois Federal No.1, lying alongside the access road, to the tie-in point to Cabot's pipeline just south of the Yates Federal AA well No.1 in the SE1/NE1/2 of Section 4, as shown on the attached Exhibit "A".

The reason for this request is to permit the sale of gas from this shut-in gas well. Although the well has not been potentialled, it is estimated gas production will be about 500 MCF per day. Gas sold will be metered at the tie-in point to Cabot's line.

Approval of this application would be in the interest of conservation and would not result in reduced royalty or improper measurement of production.
