From this point for approximately 1,150' (50' x 1,100' survey) it will parallel the south side of an abandoned lease road that has a buried pipeline in it. The project will turn south (100' x 200') at this point to rejoin the original road survey at point approximately 50' northeast of the southeast corner of the pad survey area. This part is a 100' wide survey. Footages and location of the project is an estimation.

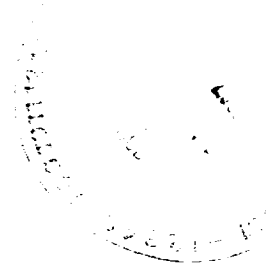
