DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Moved cable tools in 9-26-49, started swabbing, bailing and cleaning out. Cleaned out to total depth of 3063'. Shot with 60 qts. O.W.E. from 3039' to 3063'. Tamped with pea gravel from 3021' to 3039'.

Dumped 6 sacks Cal-Seal from 3003' to 3021'. Filled hole with oil. Shot at 7:00 A.M. 9-29-1949. Drilled Cal-Seal, and cleaned to total depth of 3063'. Swab test showed 45 barrels of oil first 24 hours. Run tubing and rods, put on pump 10-6-1949. Production first 24 hours was 45 barrels per day.
