Propose to plug and abandon. The 10-3/4" is set at 297' and was cemented with 150 sacks. The 7" was set at 3028' and cemented with 600 sacks. The pay sand was from 3047' to 3075'. Total depth was 3075'. We propose to load hole with mud laden fluid and to set 10 sack cement plug at 3000'. Will knock off what 7" left in hole. Will finish filling hole with mud and set regulation marker in cement plug at surface.
