Total depth 3034' in Anhydrite. Ran 86 joints, or 3028.22' of 5½" OD 14# 8 RT H-40 SS casing and 14# J-55 SS casing set at 3032.47', and cemented with 600 sacks. Plug down at 7:25 P. M. 2-2-48. Cement will be allowed to set at least 30 hours before testing for shut off. Well was drilled to 3034' with Rotary Tools, which are being moved out and balance of well will be drilled with Cable Tools.
