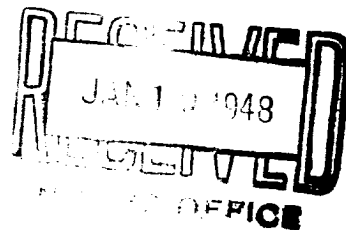

### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6 5/8" Casing was set at 3022' and cemented by Halliburton on Dec. 30 1947 with 600 Sax of cement, and plug pumped to bottom. Water shut off test was started on Jan. 6, 1948. Casing was bailed dry to top of cement found at 2985' and allowed to stand 12 hours., and no water accumulated in the hole. The cement was then drilled out of the casing with cable tools to total depth through the casing guide shoe, and the well allowed to stand without further bailing or drilling for 12 hours, and no water was found in the hole. Bailing test was completed on Jan. 11, 1948
