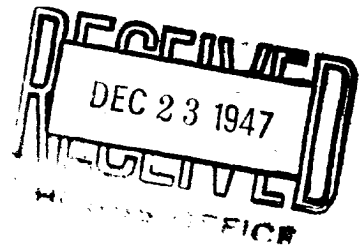

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

290' of 10 3/4" OD 35.75 Casing run and cemented with 150 sacks El Toro common cement on Dec. 12 by Halliburton. Plug pumped down at 1 December 12, 1947. Casing was hanging free in hole when cemented. Pump pressure left against plug after cementing to wait for cement to set. Pressure released Dec. 16, and then re-pressured with water pumped by our drilling pump to 400 lbs. with no pressure lost. Drilling resumed Dec. 18
