After our telephone conversation I visited the location of the H. L. Wilson Drilling Company, Continental State #1, in the NELNW- Sec. 19, T. 13S, R. 32E, Caprock Field, Lea County, New Mexico.

I find that they have spudded about a  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " hole to a depth of approximately 30°. There is no machinery at all on the location and they have not dug cellar or pits.

Enclosed is a copy of Form C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill, and a copy of Form C-103 indicating that they spudded on November 8, 1947. I am also enclosing a copy of a letter to the New Mexico Gil Conservation Commission, Santa Fe Office stating the bond was mailed to that office by Bob Daniels & Sons Insurance Agency Mout November 15, 1947.
