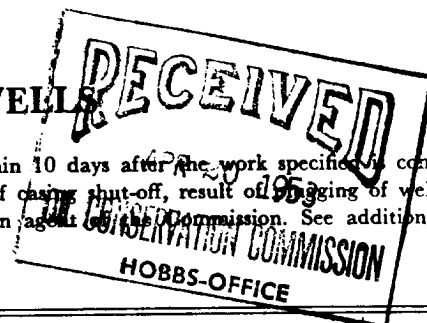

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 384.8' of 9-5/8" 36# Seamless J-55 casing and set at 3860'.  
Cemented with 2010 sacks of 3% Gel, 503 sacks of Signalite and 200 sacks  
of Neat. Circulated 400 sacks. Pipe and casing seat tested with 1250 psi  
for 30 minutes before and after the drilling out of the cement on April  
15, 1953. Both held O.K.
